

Reusable t-shirt bag

Step 1: Pick a t-shirt and turn it inside out



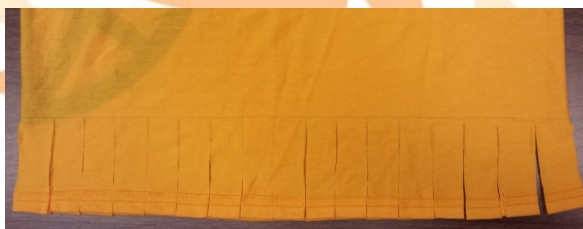
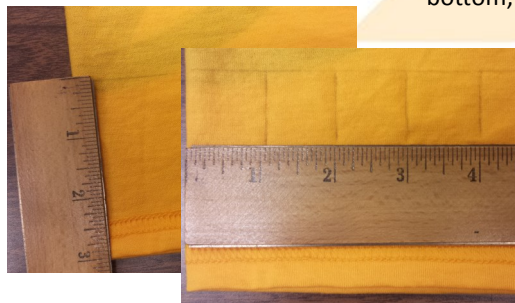
Step 3: Cut off the sleeves inside the seam



Step 4: Cut the neck a little bigger



Step 5: Cut 2-3 inch long slits at the bottom, about 1/2—1 inch wide



Step 6: Tie together slits from opposite sides



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Step 6 continued: It should look like this:



Step 7: Now tie together slits of two different but consecutive knots



Step 8: Turn your bag inside out and use!



Other ideas:

- Cut 1-2 inch long slits parallel to the bottom of the bag to allow air flow (like for produce)
- Reinforce strength of handles by stitching along the edges
- If you prefer to sew, you could easily do that along the bottom instead of knots!

Step 9: Use your scraps for another project, turn them into rags, or recycle them! Most Goodwill stores will accept textiles for recycling.



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
